

BACHELOR OF ARTS

Music

This degree is offered with a major in Music, and is intended for students who wish to emphasize general competence in music within the framework of a liberal arts education. A minimum of 180 credits is required, of which at least 90 must be taken in departments other than the School of Music, including the **Language Skills, Additional Writing, Reasoning, and Diversity**, and **20 credits in each Area of Inquiry** requirements of the College of Arts and Sciences (see below).

Music majors are required to earn a minimum grade of 2.0 in each music course (core and elective) that is to count toward music degree requirements. A GPA of 2.5 in music is required for graduation.
